TITLE ONE SCHOOLS:

What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that provides additional support to students, parents, and teachers in eligible schools.

How are Title I funds spent?

The funding provides:

- Additional Staff
- Additional Materials
- Teacher Training
- Family Involvement Activity Resources

How are students selected for additional help?

Daily classroom performance, teacher observation, administrative recommendation, and performance on various assessments.

(PALS, SOLs, QRI etc.) are all considered when selecting students for additional help. Contact your child's school with any specific questions.

How YOU can be Involved?

There are many ways to be involved at your child's school and with the Title I program! Going to parent/teacher conferences, joining the PTA, and attending special activities at the school are all GREAT ways to be involved!

How long do students receive additional help?

Extra help may be provided on a short-term or long-term basis. Teachers use a variety of assessments to monitor progress and determine instructional needs.
